# Proposals for Flood Mitigation along Wakehurst Parkway

Friends of Narrabeen Lagoon Catchment sent in a submission on behalf of our members and supporters—we did not support any of the options that were on offer and we have requested that the public be informed of the costs of modifying the road to bring it above the flood waters rather than disturbing 3 ha of bushland to create a partial solution to the problem. Future flooding events are likely to be more frequent due to Climate Change.

## **Ingleside Place Strategy**

The Department of Planning released a document describing plans for creating 980 dwellings in Ingleside. Unfortunately, there were many shortfalls in these plans. On behalf of our members and supporters, Friends of Narrabeen Lagoon Catchment wrote a submission outlining the many reasons why we felt these plans were unsuitable.



Northern Beaches Council on July 27, voted to request Dept of Planning not to go ahead with their plans but that, instead, Northern Beaches would accommodate that number of additional houses in other already built up parts of the LGA.
